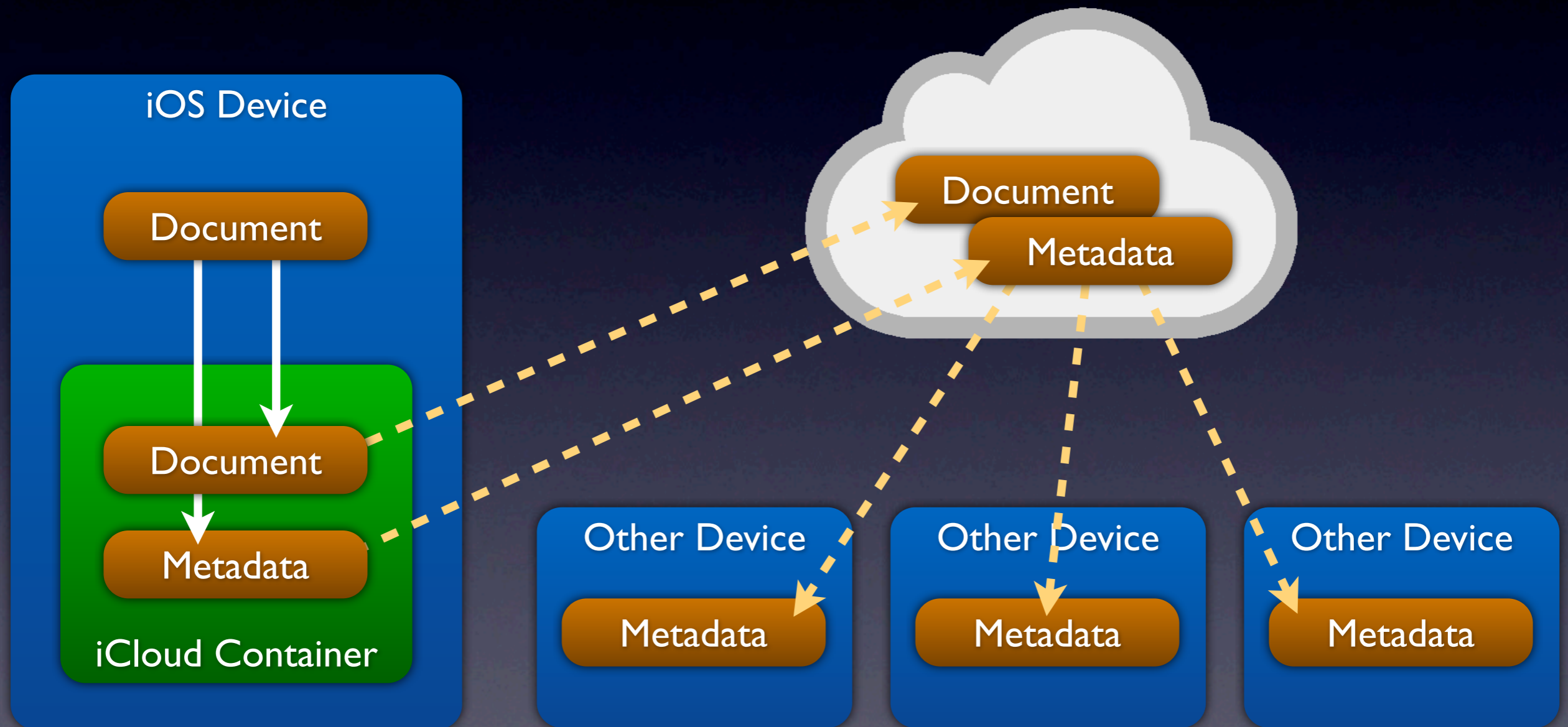
iCloud Storage Isn't

- ❌ Remote storage
- ❌ Communication channel between users
- ❌ General communication between apps

So, What Is It?

- ✓ Sync data and documents among devices
- ✓ One user
- ✓ One app
- ✓ Or a tightly integrated suite of apps

How It Works



Advantages

- ✓ Work offline
- ✓ Minimizes bandwidth usage
- ✓ All devices notified of changes
- ✓ Devices download data on demand

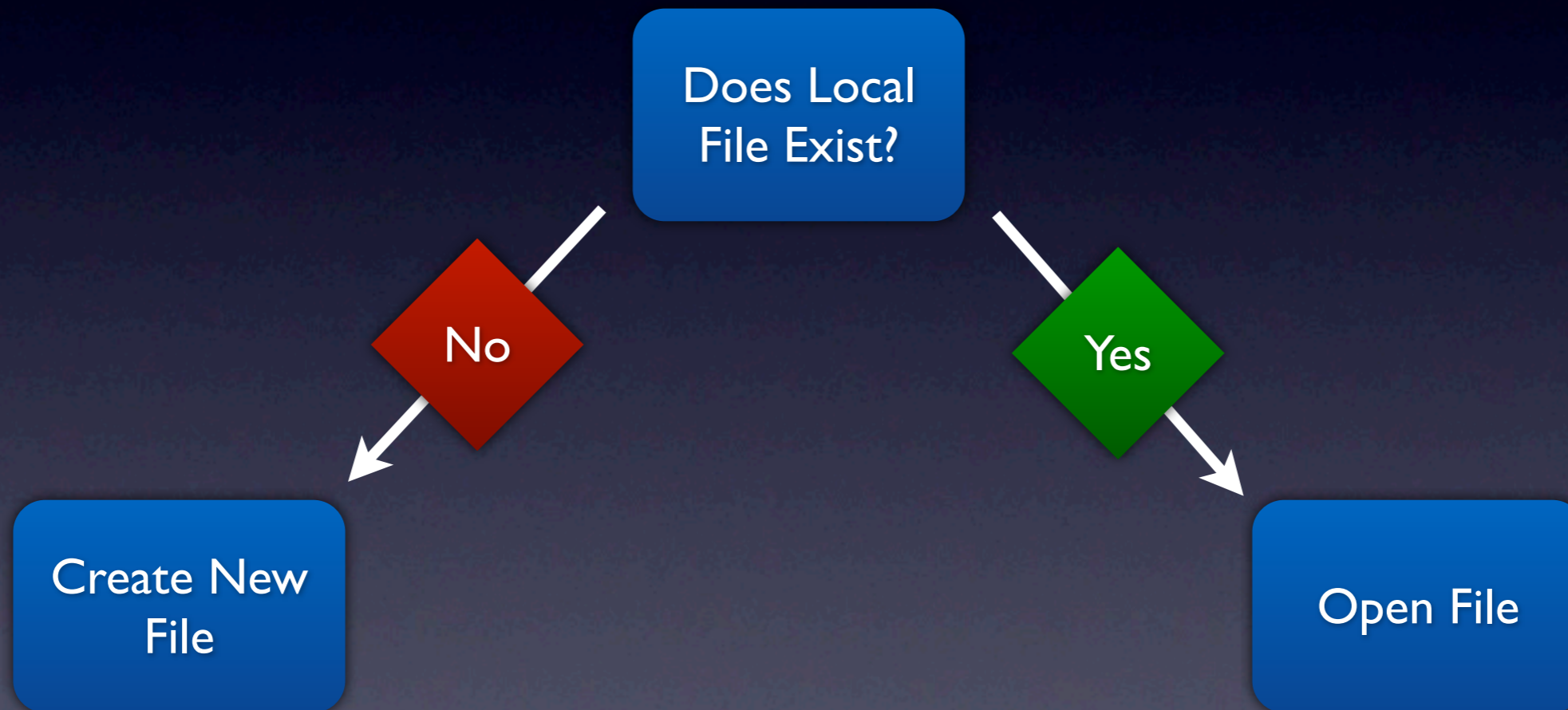
Challenges

- Ensure iCloud is enabled
- Search for file URL
- Coordinate file i/o on the device
- Manage conflicts between devices
- No SQLite databases
 - ✓ Unless you use Core Data

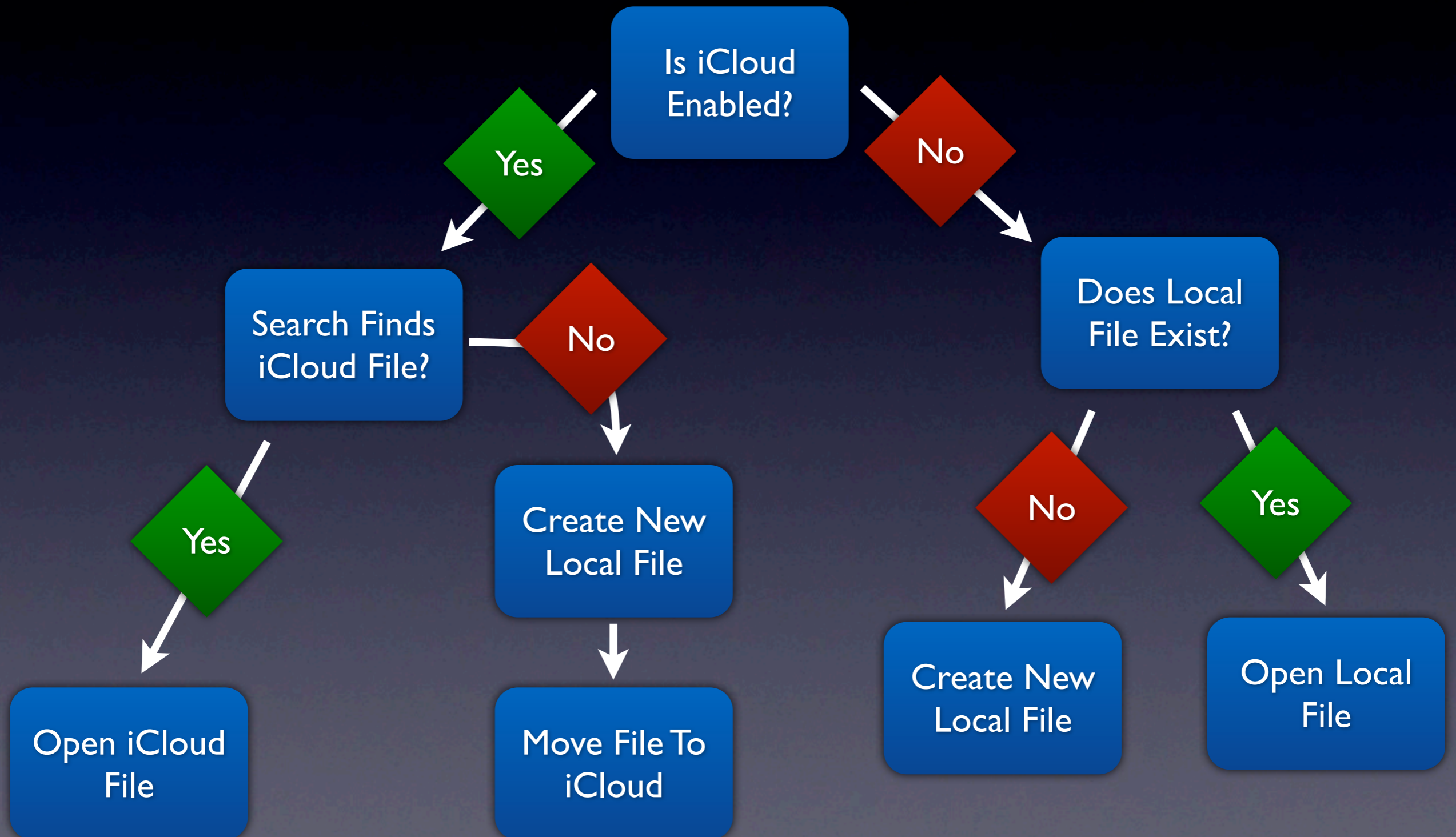
Core Data

- SQLite database never goes to the cloud
- Syncs transaction logs
- Must delete logs when you delete the file
- Core Data automatically merges conflicts

Unintended Consequences



Data Format Problem

- Update changes data format
- User updates some devices
- Opens file in new app
- New data sent to iCloud
- Old app downloads update

Some Possible Effects

- ✓ Nothing
- ⊘ User loses new data
- ⊘ Document fails to load
- ⊘ Application crashes
- ⊘ Data corrupted
- ⊘ Uploads corrupted data to iCloud
- ⊘ Updates ping-pong back and forth

Possible Solutions

- ✓ Robust error checking
- ✓ Change the data's Uniform Type Identifier
- ✓ Add and check version metadata
- ✓ Test for problems before you release
