Apple ID

- Needs a valid email address
- *appleid.apple.com & [iForgot.apple.com](https://iforgot.apple.com)
- *You cannot setup more than three Apple ID's on a single machine
- *You can contact Apple to white list your IP for creating 10 or more Apple ID's from a location.

Apple ID

- Gets you into Apple Services: iTunes, App Store, Mac App Store, iCloud...
- Reset Password from Login Screen
- NEEDED to update Purchased Software
- NOT needed for System Updates

iCloud

- Free 5GB (\$40.00/Year 20GB, \$100.00/Year 100GB)
- Sync Mail/Contacts/Calendars
- Backup & Restore iOS Device
- Data & Documents (Pages, Keynote, Numbers)
- Find My iPhones, iPad, Mac, etc..
- *Trial-ish: Refunds within 15days or within 45 days of yearly payment.

iTunes Store

- What is a device in Apple lingo (Mac, PC, iOs)
- Content from multiple Apple ID's on an a device
- Apple's new treatment of "devices"
- *Apple TV recently received multiple login

iTunes Store

- Synchronizing: Wired, Wifi, Or Cloud
- Home Sharing (iTunes, Apple Remote, Apple TV)
- Old hardware to new hardware

iTunes Match

\$24.99 per year. Cheap

- Sync, Stream & legitimize music
- Supports up to 10 devices
- iCloud backend feature, iCloud account not required

Mac App Store

- A curated Mac only App store
- Simple (Apple ID) and Secure (Code Signed)
- Install apps on as many machines for personal use.
- Backup your purchases

- Redemption
- Deployment and Imaging (ARD/net install/net restore)
- Multiple Installations (One Apple ID or Multiple Apple ID)

- Not officially Supported
- Changing Account Information
- Personal iTunes, iCloud, Developer, ACN
- Best practice for organization Apple IDs (iCloud & App Store)

Security-Two Step Authentication

- Step #1: Verifies the device you pick (sends SMS)
- Doesn't show passcode if device is locked
- asks for mobile number (you can go back and add or verify more trusted devices, or remove them)
- any SMS messages are free: This SMS message is free Verifies the number you put in
- Step #2: FA-KECO-DEIS-HERE (Recovery Key used if device unavailable)
- (Interesting note, can't copy and paste) –Recommended to print or write down, but don't save in computer.

Security-Two Step Authentication cont'd

- Step 3 –you will have to retype (can't copy paste) into field to move forward
- Step 4 Accept Terms
- Test: Login, Send by text, approved device, or recovery key

- *Multiple failed logins will lead to an automatic account lock
