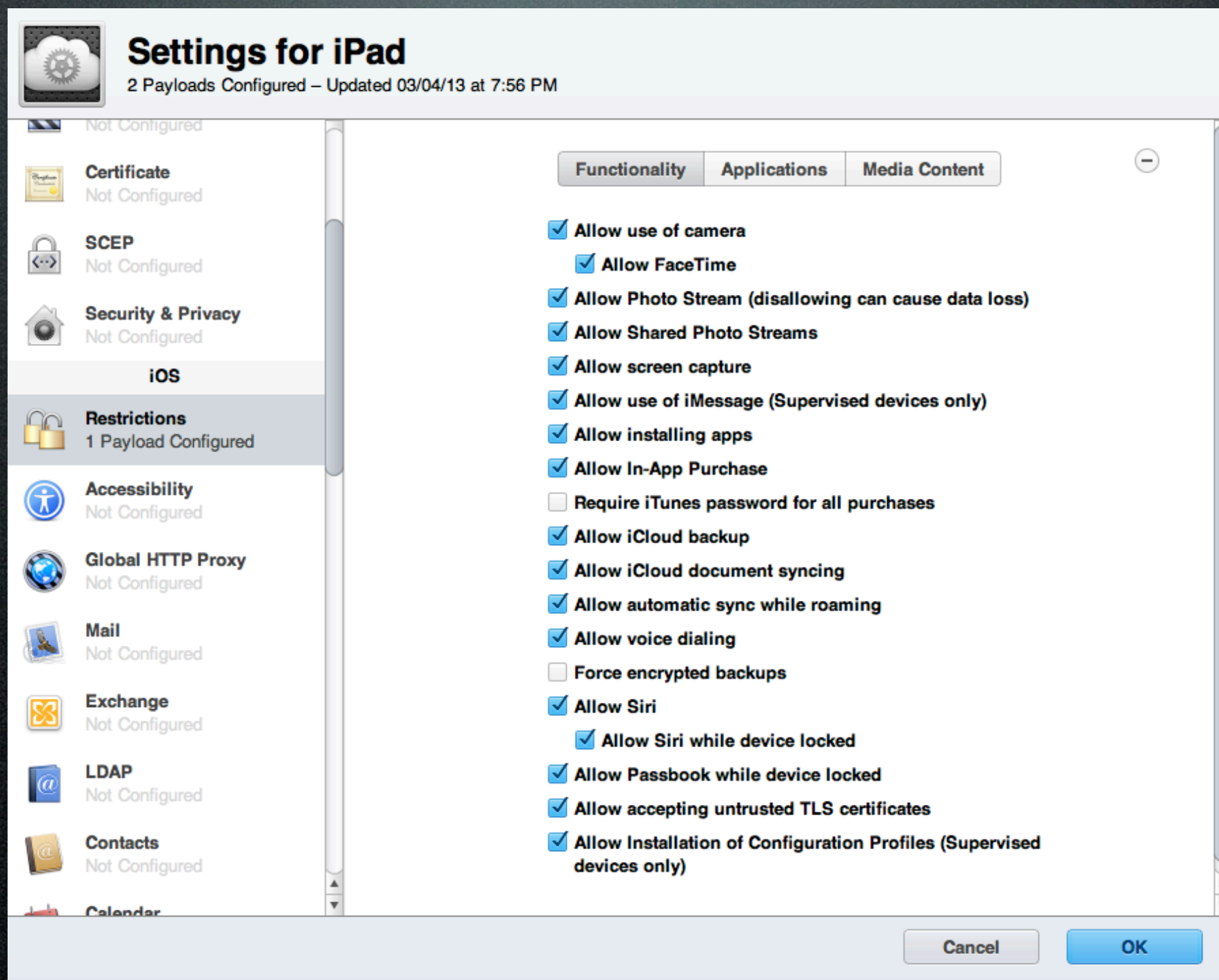

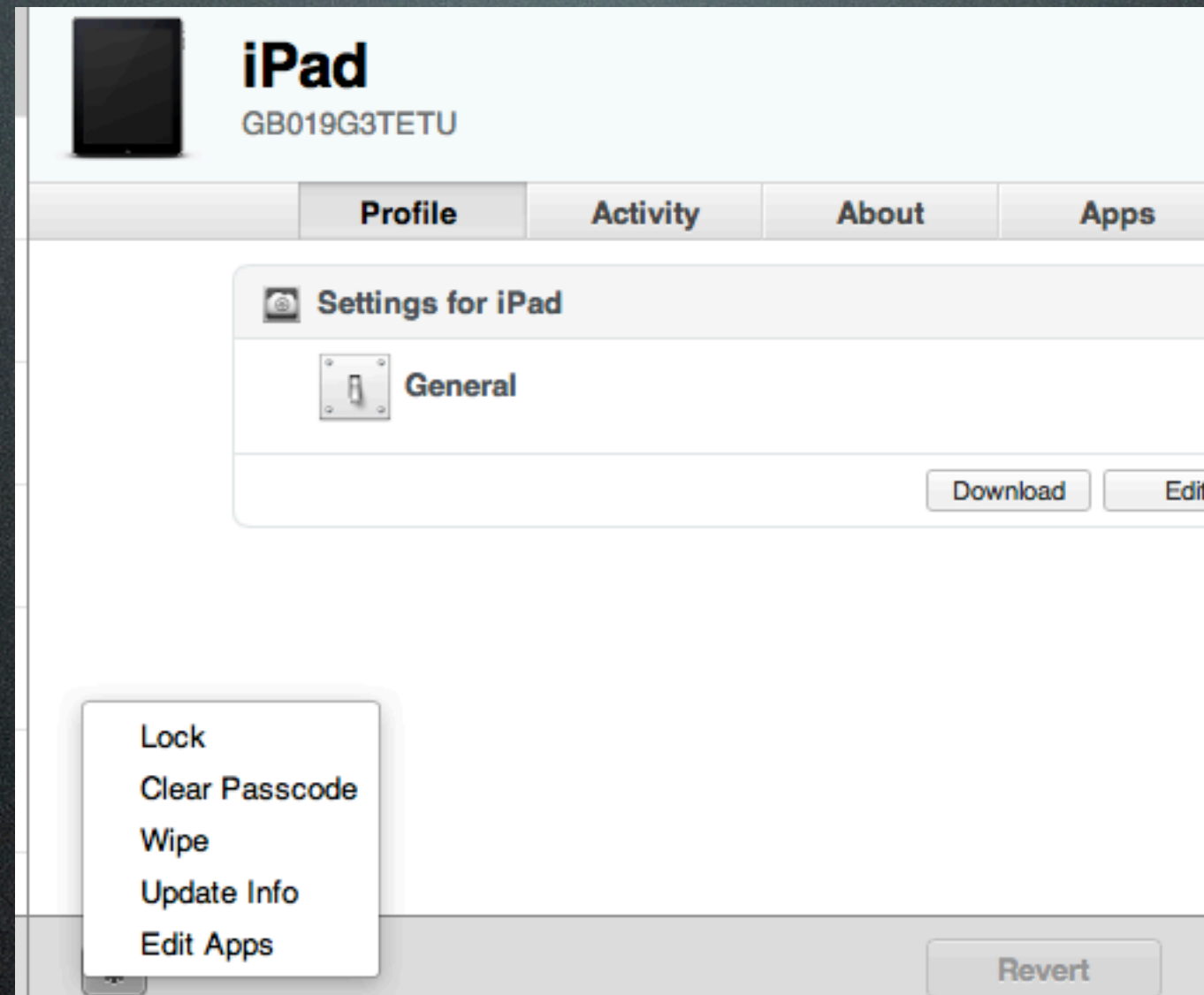

MDM landscape

- Early on it was all about email
 - Blackberry BES
 - Exchange ActiveSync
- Then calendars & contacts
- Now a logical extension of desktop management (w/all the mobile requirements)
- Moving towards isolation of personal data/apps from company data/apps

BYOD is Here to Stay

- BYOD will be less an option, and more a mandate, for employment —Gartner
- 50% of businesses will demand employees participate in BYOD programs in the near future
- Procure less devices, offer more purchase allowances

MDM building blocks

- Web Service/Database
- Directory (OD/AD/LDAP)
- Certificates
- Profile Generator for all device functionality
- Connected to Apple Push Notification Service (APNs) to notify devices of updates
- Apple Volume Purchase Program (VPP)

- iCloud...Not for Business
- Apple Configurator
- OS X Profile Manager (10.8)

- Apple or Third Party MDM?
 - Non iOS Devices
 - Features
 - Granular control
 - OTA Application Deployment
 - GeoFencing!!!
 - Money

Yours vs. Hosted vs. Cloud

- Building, maintaining, replacing infrastructure
- Solution mobility; data mobility
- Total Cost of Ownership (remember eng./adm!!!)
 - Yours: server hardware + server software +++
 - Hosted Casper / robotcloud.net
= \$5/month/device
 - Cloud-based Maas360

Business drives implementation

- Who owns the equipment?
- BYOD (Bring your own device)?
- Who controls the equipment?

Deployment

- Devices already out there
- Mass Deployment
 - Initial setup Apple Configurator
 - Directory integration

iCloud MDM

- Inventory - each device!
- Configuration via iTunes - each device!
 - also does backups!
- Security Management
 - Find My iThing
- Distribution - App Store
 - Provide redemption codes via email
 - User uses personal Apple ID!

Apple Configurator

- Everything you wanted in a MDM, except the M
- Prepare mode - imaging
- Supervise mode - imaging + app management
 - The ONLY solution for app distribution where you can revoke applications and redemption code can be re-used

OS X Server Profile Manager

- Everything you wanted in an MDM, except app management and platform agnosticism
- Reference for iOS profiles
- Automatically sets up Apple Push Notification Service (APNs), and certs/profiles for device enrollment
- \$19! (+Server +Admin +access)

Maas360

- An example of a 3rd Party MDM

Issues

- Apple ID
 - From MacWorld - “...An Apple ID is for an individual person, and Apple has no concept of a corporate ID. You don't get around that, you surrender to it.”
 - You **MUST** have a strategy for managing
- Apple Push Notification Service integration

More Considerations

- Role-based Apple IDs (Purchases, Certs, Admin)
- Apple Volume Purchasing Program (VPP)
- Certificates - Used everywhere to establish trust, and encrypt/decrypt information
 - hard to generate, hard to import, hard to export, and they expire (Much easier than it used to be!)
- Wiping can destroy personal data
