What happens when my subscription ends?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Customers will receive notification of upcoming expiration in the Office applications.• If the Office 365 subscription expires, the applications enter reduced functionality mode; customers can only view or print existing documents. <p>Customers have options to continue to use Office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Renew by purchasing another 1-year subscription.• Return to using their previous version of Office, if possible.• For basic editing, use the free Office Web Apps on SkyDrive.

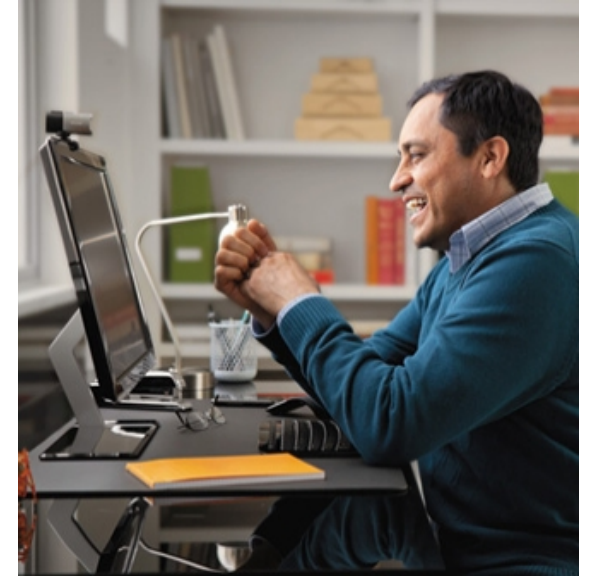

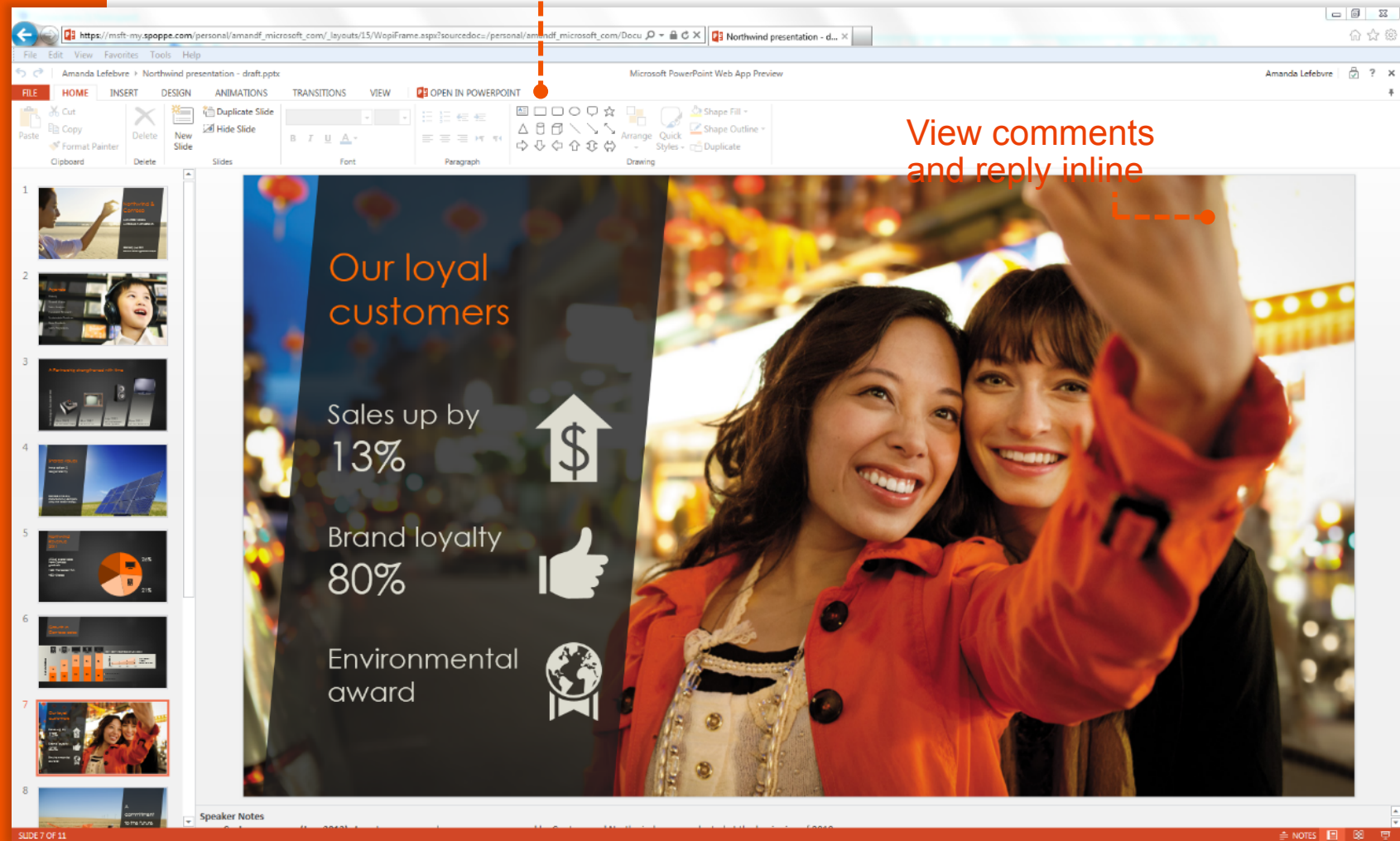

Questions you may hear...

Do I need more than one Office 365 Small Business Premium Product Key for my business?

One user license (or Product Key) is included with each box of Small Business Premium. **Organizations must purchase 1 Product Key per user.**

However, **each user may install Office applications on up to 5 of the user's own PCs or Macs, plus supported mobile devices.**



Questions you may hear...

Can customers access their documents if they are not online?

Yes. When a customer saves a document in Office, the file is saved to a **local SkyDrive folder** on their PC, so they can access the file at any time—without an Internet connection.

If the customer chooses to also save the file to **SkyDrive Pro** (included with Office 365 Small Business Premium), the next time the customer is online, the SkyDrive folder automatically **syncs to SkyDrive in the Microsoft cloud**. This allows easy access on the user's multiple devices from anywhere.

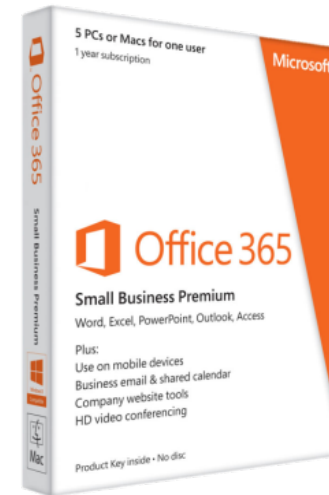

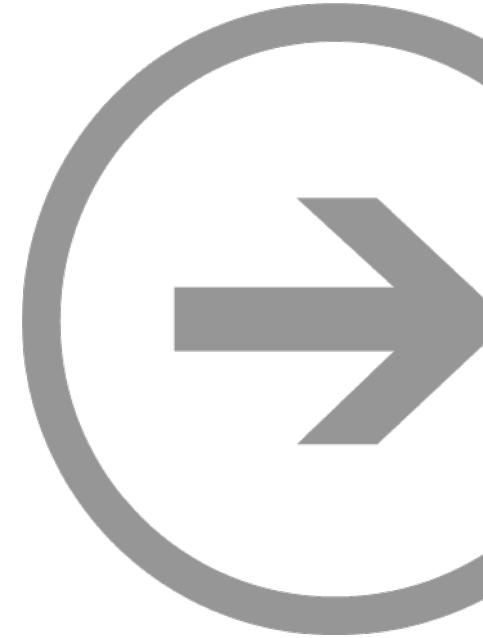
