



- Based on an email address (or username)
- Note: @mac.com and @me.com Apple IDs can not be renamed.
- Apple ID is related to an account with Apple
- Account contains purchase history






Apple ID Rules


- Valid Email Address as your user name
- Secure Password Criteria
- 3 Security Questions
- Date of Birth
- Rescue Email Address [optional]
- Mailing Address
- 2 Step Verification [optional]
- Management Web Site is SSL encrypted

Two Factor Authentication

Two-step verification for Apple ID.

Two-step verification will require you to verify your identity using one of your devices before you can make changes to your account or make an iTunes or App Store purchase from a new device.



You enter your Apple ID and password as usual.

We send a verification code to one of your devices.

You enter the code to verify your identity and complete sign in.

You will also get a **Recovery Key** for safekeeping which you can use to access your account if you ever forget your password or lose your device.



Learn how to change the email address that you use as your Apple ID.

In most cases, your Apple ID is also the [primary email address](#) of your Apple ID account. You can change your Apple ID to any address, except an address used by another Apple ID. You can change the address of any Apple ID, **except an Apple ID that ends with @icloud.com, @me.com, or @mac.com.**


1. Sign out of iCloud, the iTunes Store, App Store, FaceTime, Find My Friends, Find My iPhone, and iMessage on each device that uses your current Apple ID for these services.
2. Go to My Apple ID (appleid.apple.com).
3. Select "Manage your Apple ID" and sign in. [Forgot your password?](#)
4. Select Edit next to "Apple ID and Primary Email Address."
5. Enter the email address to use as your Apple ID, then select Save Changes. Apple will send a verification email to that address.
6. Open the email from Apple, then click Verify Now in the email. [Didn't receive the email?](#)
7. When the My Apple ID page opens, sign in with your renamed Apple ID.
8. When you see a message that verification is complete, you can begin using your renamed Apple ID. You should also [update the features and services](#) that you use with Apple ID.



- Migration Assistant is your friend

- All Media and Device Backups Come Over
- Deauthorize old computer
- Authorize new computer
- iOS Device? Restore from iCloud Backup

- All your music on All your devices
 - 25,000 songs from your library
 - count does not include music purchased from iTunes
 - up to 10 devices including your Apple TV
 - streaming vs playing directly from device

 - MacBook Pro
 - iMac
 - MacMini
 - MacPro



Limitations



- Limit of 5 computers (Mac or PC) authorized for iTunes with a single Apple ID. (Legacy DRM)
- Limit of 10 authorized devices. (New iCloud)
- Sync unlimited number of devices.
- Limit of 3 Apple IDs tied to iCloud *created* on a given device through the device's *lifetime!*

NOT SURE...

- Limit of content from 5 different accounts on a single device.

Troubleshooting

- Your email address has changed, but your AppleID hasn't
 - Log into appleid.apple.com
 - Authenticate
 - Remove the old email address. Save the change.
 - Log out, then log back into appleid.apple.com
 - Add a new email address as the primary, it will send a verification, go to the new email account and verify the email address.
 - Go back to appleid.apple.com and verify that the email address is verified.
- Changing a Credit Card Free AppleID to a credit card enabled AppleID and back again.
