Apple ID Basics

- Key to personalization
 - Website
 - Devices



Apple ID Rules

- EULA
 - Read and understand
- People under age 13 cannot create
 - Legal requirements (COPPA and others)
 - Apple ID for Students for Education
 - Family Sharing for families

Personal vs. Institutional

- Personal
 - Owned by the user
 - Allows for personalization
 - Can use on devices
- Institutional
 - Owned by the institution
 - Access institutional assets
 - Treat as an institutional asset
 - Don't use on devices

- iBooks
- iTunes U
- iCloud
 - Find My iPhone
 - Backup

Device Enrollment Program

- Zero-touch MDM enrollment
- Over-the-air supervision
- Required MDM enrollment
- Optional user-based enrollment



Volume Purchase Program



- Bulk purchasing of App Store assets
- Volume discounts for Education
- Codes or managed distribution
- Flexible app management

Apple ID for Students

- Allow institution to create Apple IDs for young students
- COPPA compliance
- Requires parent/guardian consent
- Bulk creation for students



ADP Enrollment

- New institutional Apple IDs
- Program agent
- Program admins
- Get started at deploy.apple.com
- Help at <https://www.apple.com/support/business-education/>
- Spend some time with the help docs

DEP Eligibility

- Direct purchases
- Reseller purchases
- Devices purchased in the last few years
- Running iOS 7 or Mavericks (and newer)



Mobile Device Management



- The central actor
- Required for DEP
- Interface for Managed Distribution

APNS

- Apple Push Notification Service
- Delivers OTA notifications to subscribed devices
- Used by many apps and services
- Critical to MDM
- Authenticated by a certificate
- Issued to an Apple ID

New this Fall

Old School

- Codes
 - Gifts
 - Apple Configurator
- Managed Distribution
 - Licenses managed through MDM
 - Invite users
 - Assign apps to them



New School

- Managed Distribution
- Assign to devices
- Codes not needed
- User-based Managed Distribution



Device-based App Assignment

- iOS 9
- OS X El Capitan
- Apple Configurator 2
- MDM



Migrations

- Unmanaged app to managed app
- User-assigned app to device-assigned app
- Require MDM support
- Verify your MDM supports migration



Apple Configurator 2



- Totally new app
- Prepares iOS devices
- Works with DEP

Apple Configurator 2



- Works with VPP
- Does device assignment
- Sideload apps and content
- Can be automated
- Personal Apple ID or enterprise apps, too

- Blueprints
- Automator
- Command line tool cfgutil
- AppleScript/JavaScript

- Apple Products are designed to:
 - Work certain ways
 - Work together
- Get on board
 - Don't make life harder than it is
 - Use the tools that are available

Register

- Sign up for the deployment programs
- Use every one that makes sense
- Institutional assets



Get MDM

- Invest in MDM
- Investigate products
- Choose wisely
- Use AC2 where appropriate



Stop Bad Habits

- No “generic” Apple IDs
 - Assign to devices instead
 - Avoid the pain of mass creation
- Let devices live up to their potential
 - Don’t over-manage
 - Let users personalize with their own Apple ID

Use the Available Tools

- Onboard with DEP
- Assign mission critical apps
- Contain enterprise data
 - Where appropriate
 - With managed apps and restrictions
- Leverage MDM
 - Help the end user be successful
 - Then get out of their way
- Use Caching Server

Advocate the Apple Way

- Out-of-box experience for everyone
- Empower the end user to do great things
- Manage as much as necessary
 - And as little as possible
